
WHAT TO DO IF YOUR CHILD IS HAVING A SEIZURE

Give midazolam if the seizure lasts over 5 minutes or if ______ seizures happen within ______ minutes

SEIZURE STARTS





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Head tilted to recovery position midazolam (15mg/3ml) keep airway open. CONTINUES gF. Hands support head. Mouth is toward the ground. Knee stops body Give midazolam into the side STOPS from rolling. of the cheek (buccally) Let child rest & recover Call 111 unless instructed otherwise by your doctor Stay with them until back to normal **Record in seizure diary** If advised, let medical team know Dr gF.
